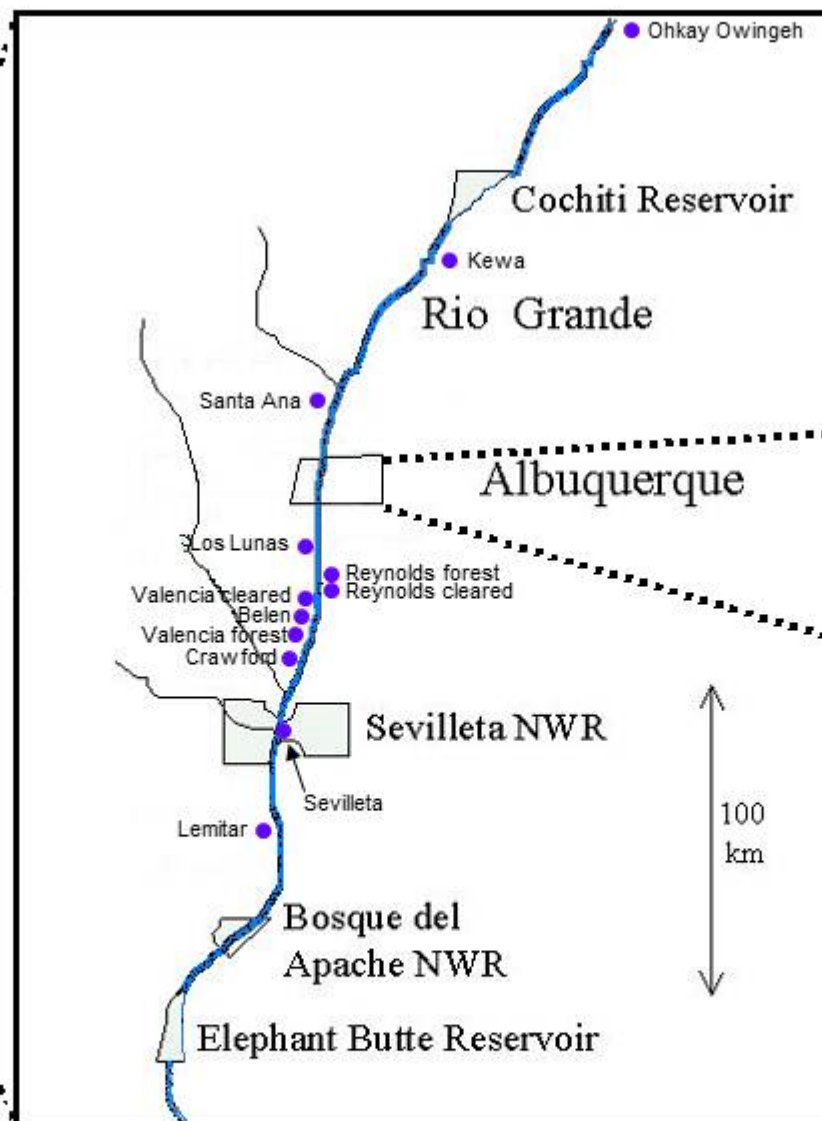
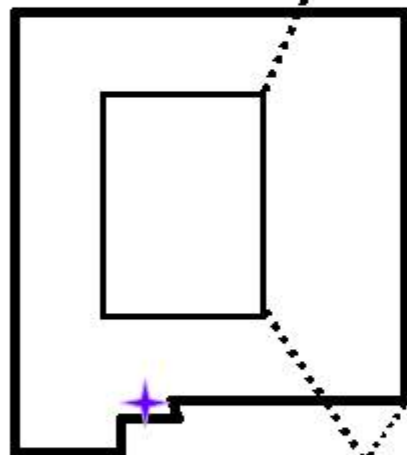






## Did you know???

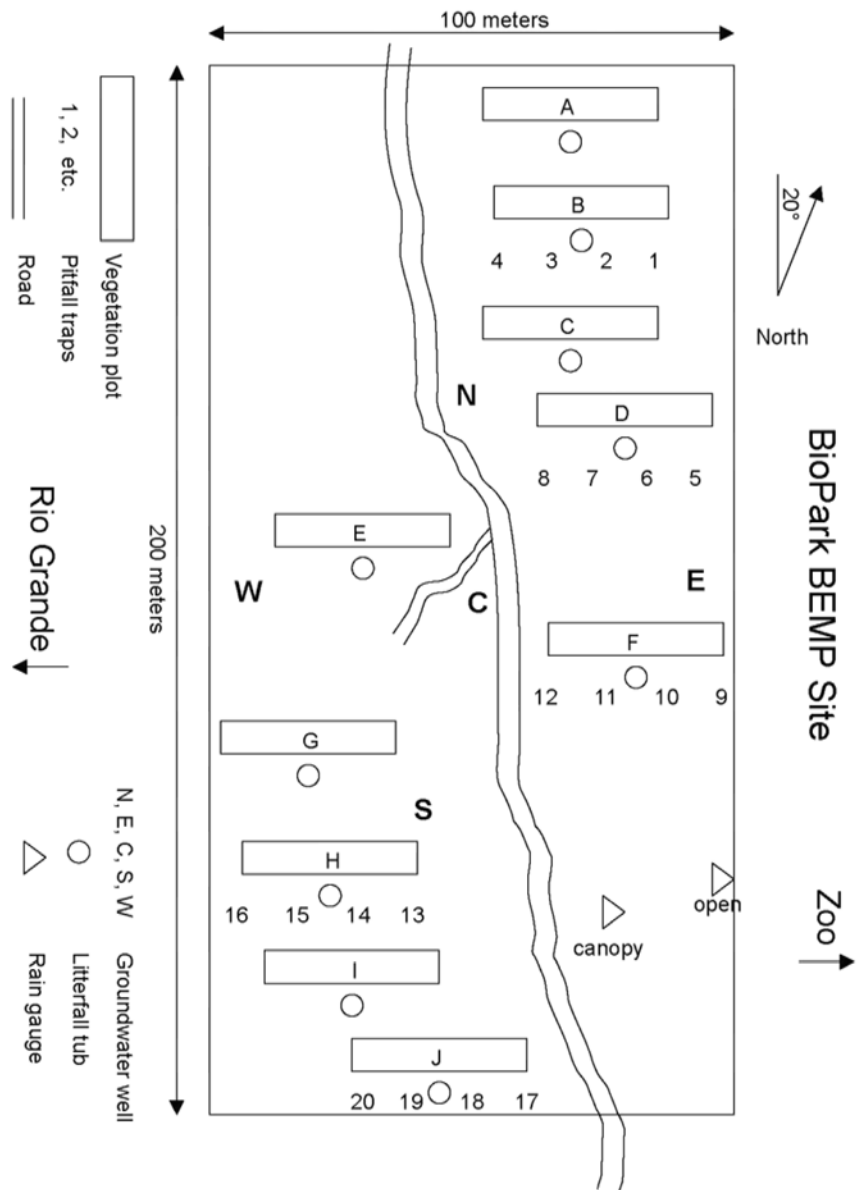
